Maths - This term, children will be:

- Counting forwards and backwards to and from 10.
- Grouping an amount of objects together.

Literacy:

Children will be learning to write in full sentences using finger spaces, full stops and capital letters.

Children will begin to use conjunctions and adjectives.

Phonics Focus:

We will continue to work in groups for our phonics lessons using the Twinkl phonics scheme.

Science:

Children will perform a taste test to investigate their senses.

Children will be able to name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is to do with each sense.

Children will be able to explain changes and describe the weather in autumn.

Computing

Children will identify technology around them.

Children will identify a computer and its main parts.

Children will begin to use a mouse and a keyboard.

Children will create rules for using technology responsibly

RE - Christianity - Does God want Christians to Look after the world?

- Children will say how it feels to make something.
- Children will remember the Christian creation story and talk about it.
- Children will express an opinion about the Christian belief about creation

Geography - Maps

Children will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and it's grounds.
