

Year 2 Term 3 Newsletter 2024

Our topic over the next 2 terms will be focusing on:

Wriggle and Crawl/Beachcombers

Our key question is:

How do life cycles differ from one species to another?

<u>Maths:</u> Statistics, addition and subtraction, 2D and 3D shapes, measure and Multiplying by 2,5 and 10.

<u>Literacy:</u> confidently using nouns, verbs and adjectives into their everyday writing, commas in a list, using 'and' or 'but' to join sentences, using adverbs to describe a verb, imperative verbs and past tense.

Science - Growth & Survival

- To find out about the offspring of a variety of animals
- To find out about how different animals reproduce
- To explore how humans grow as they get older
- To find out what animals, including humans, need to survive
- To explore the environment as a factor of survival for animals, including humans.
- To find out why exercise is important to keep our bodies healthy.

Art - colour creations

- To identify primary colours.
- To mix primary colours to create secondary colours.
- To create light and dark shades of colour.
- To produce art based on the work of Paul Klee.

Computing - Pictograms

- To recognise that we can count and compare objects using tally charts
- To recognise that objects can be represented by pictures
- To create a pictogram
- To create a pictogram to arrange objects by an attribute
- To create a pictogram from a suitable attribute to compare people.

- To find out about what Judaism is and what Jews believe.
- To find out how the Torah began on Mount Sinai.
- To find out how the Torah is used by Jews today.

- To find out what the Torah teaches Jews about helping others.
