


<u> Year Four - Term 5 Newsletter 2024</u>

Our topic over the next term will focus on Road Trip USA

Our Lead Enquiry question is: What are the main similarities and differences between the UK and the USA?




<u>English</u>: We will be writing narratives, based on our USA theme, with a clear beginning, middle and end with a clear plot. In these stories, we will also be creating more detailed settings, characters and plots to engage our readers.

This term, will read, recite, perform, understand and compose different types of poetry based around the USA.

<u>PSHE -</u>

We will learn about medicines and household products, as well as drugs common to everyday life.

Discussions will be had about the importance of taking medicines correctly and using household products safely.





<u>Science:</u>

We will look at how to make simple circuits, learning the names of different components and how each of these works. We will investigate insulators and conductors and use this knowledge to make a switch. Finally, we will challenge ourselves to make our very own electrical devices.

<u>ART</u>


We will discuss how graffiti polarises opinion, identify distinctive features of graffiti art and consider where it is, and is not, appropriate to make graffiti art. We will study and respond to images of stencil street art by Banksy, and consider why art in this style is also popular with advertisers. After that, we will go on to learn how stencils may be created, then design and make our own stencils.


